


Primo Plaid Flannels: Sew Sweet

Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions
Fabric A- Weave – Pink U014-0125 1/3 yard Cut one 10 ½" square. 1/2 yard 1/3 yard
Fabric B- Weave – BlueU014-01511/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric C- Plaid #1 – PinkU054-01261/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x WOF strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric D- Plaid #1 – BlueU054-01501/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x WOF strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric E- Plaid #2 – Pink/BlueU055-01251/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x WOF strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric F- Plaid #2 – YellowU055-01331/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x WOF strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric G- Plaid #2 – Pink/PurpleU055-01721/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x WOF strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric H- Plaid #3 – BlueU056-01221/3 yardCut one 10 ½" x WOF strip.Sub-cut the strip into two 10 ½" squares.
Fabric I- Plaid #3 – TurquoiseU056-01513/8 yardCut three 3 ½" x WOF strips.Sub-cut the strips into thirty 3 ½" squares.
Fabric J- Plaid #4 – White/BlueU057-01501 1/4 yardsCut four 10 ½" x WOF strips.Sub-cut the strips into ninety-eight 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
Fabric K- Plaid #5 – OrangeU058-01282/3 yardCut two 10 ½" x WOF strips.Sub-cut the strips into four 10 ½" squares.
Fabric L- Plaid #5 – Yellow U058-0133 2/3 yard Cut two 10 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into forty-nine 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
Fabric M- Plaid #5 – PurpleU058-1651 yardCut one 10 ½" square.Cut seven 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
Decking Divid #4 White/Divid U057 0142

Backing- Plaid #4 – White/Pink U057-0142 3 1/2 yards Cut two 63" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 55" x 68" back.

Block Assembly

- 1. Sew one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the one 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric L strip lengthwise to make one Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1). Repeat to make forty-nine Unit 1 strips total.
- 2. Sew five 3 ½" Fabric I squares and four Unit 1 strips together end to end and alternating them to make one Sashing Strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make six Sashing Strips total.

Quilt Assembly

(refer to the quilt layout while assembling the quilt top)

- Sew one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric H square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric K square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric A square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric D square and one Unit 1 strip together in that order to make Row One.
- Sew one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric F square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric G square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric E square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric K square and one Unit 1 strip together in that order to make Row Two.
- Sew one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric C square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric B square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric F square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric M square and one Unit 1 strip together in that order to make Row Three.
- Sew one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric D square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric E square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric K square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric B square and one Unit 1 strip together in that order to make Row Four.
- Sew one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric K square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric H square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric G square, one Unit 1 strip, one 10 ½" Fabric C square and one Unit 1 strip together in that order to make Row Five.
- Sew the six sashing Strips and five pieced rows, in numerical order, together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.
- 9. Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the seven 2 ¹/₂" x WOF Fabric M strips together, end to end with 45° seams, to make the binding. Fold this

long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

11. Bind as desired.
